WELCOME!

We are thankful to have you worshiping with us this morning.

Christ is risen! The resurrection of lesus Christ is the center of the Christian faith. If lesus didn't rise from the dead, then the Apostle Paul says we are still in our sins. But the Scriptures proclaim and the Church testifies that on that first Sunday after the crucifixion, Jesus burst out of His tomb. Women were the first witnesses of His resurrection and later His disciples and many others saw Him, spoke with Him, ate with Him, and touched Him. When Jesus rose from the dead, the Bible teaches that Jesus conquered the power of sin and death and Satan, and began a new creation of this world. His resurrection is the down payment and our certainty that our bodies and this whole creation which groans under the weight of sin and death will be raised up and glorified forever. We are forgiven and free now, and we will receive our inheritance at our resurrections. Since the earliest days, followers of Jesus have gathered on the first day of the week (Sunday) in commemoration of that first Easter. In this sense, every Sunday is an Easter Sunday. But it has seemed fitting to mark that first Easter in a special way annually, and for many centuries, the Church has celebrated Easter for fifty days, recounting and remembering the forty days in which Jesus was seen and heard after His resurrection before His ascension, and culminating on Pentecost, the Fiftieth Day, when our Living Savior sent His Life Giving Spirit to share His endless life with us here and now and to empower us to carry out the mission of God for the renewal of the whole earth. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!

NICENE CREED
